Since 2001, Steps has addressed the unique needs of over 5,000 students from low-income families, ensuring they not only graduate but also excel both academically and personally. In partnership with the Public Schools of Brookline and Brookline Housing Authority, Steps to Success closes the opportunity gap and stands as the sole comprehensive resource for these youth.

Steps doesn't merely promise results; it delivers them.

96%

of students in afterschool programs exhibit growth in social-emotional skills such as engagement and communication.

95%

of students show growth in the skills targeted by STEM and arts enrichment programs.

99%

of student interns meet or exceed supervisor expectations in the Career Connections program.

93%

of student interns report feeling better prepared to consider and explore different career options.

88%

of college students are on track to graduate within four to six years, six times the national average for first-generation, low-income students.

100%

of Career Connections participants create a resume and successfully complete their internship placements.

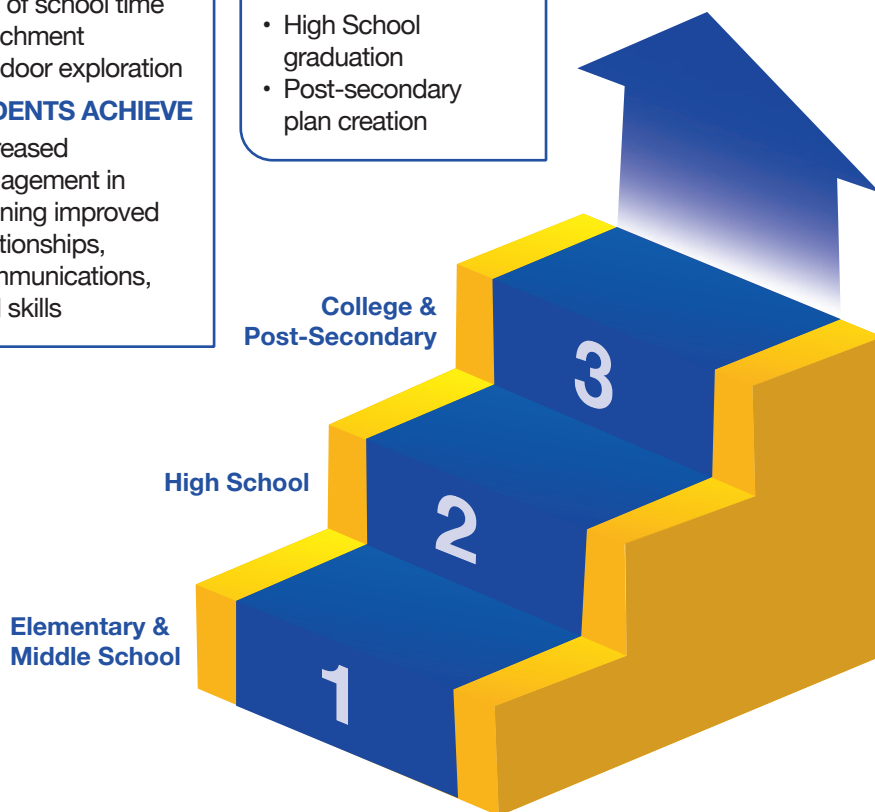
